Thank you in advance for your support to make our testing week smooth and successful for all our students. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to contact me.



#### **Registration Information**

#### **Centennial Elementary School**

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Online registration for all current elementary students who will be returning in the 2024-2025 school year begins April 8, 2024. We hope online registration will save you time and will improve the accuracy of our records. Please follow the two steps below to register your student, and feel free to contact the school at (520) 696-8200 for assistance. (Note: New students should register in person at the school office, and students who will be attending Flowing Wells Junior High School next year will receive information in June for the July online registration process.)

#### STEP 1: Establish a PowerSchool Parent Portal Account (as soon as possible)

If you already have established a PowerSchool Parent Portal account, simply use your existing login information. If you have not yet established a Power School Parent Portal account, we recommend establishing this account as soon as possible rather than waiting until the registration window opens. See the attached handout for directions to establish this account and to link your student's information to your account.

#### STEP 2: Register your Student (beginning April 8)

Log on to your PowerSchool Parent Portal account. On the lower left side of the screen, select "Registration 2024-2025." Enter information as prompted until you have completed all required fields, and then select "Submit."

#### 1er paso: establezca una cuenta en el portal para padres PowerSchool (lo más pronto posible)

#### 2<sup>do</sup> paso: Matricule a su estudiante (comenzando el 8 de abril)

Inicie la sesión a su cuenta en el portal para padres PowerSchool. En la parte de abajo izquierda de la pantalla, seleccione "Registration 2024-2025." Ingrese la información de acuerdo a las preguntas o instrucciones hasta que haya completado todas las áreas, entonces selecciones "Submit."
